Prepare Kids for Social Situations Before events, explain:

- · Who will be there
- How long it will last

Watch for Overstimulation

Lots of noise, visitors, lights, and sugar can overwhelm children.

Signs they're done: clinginess, irritability, zoning out, hyperactivity.

Give them:

- · A quiet space
- A walk outside
- A simple sensory break such as deep Breaths.
