🍷 Child Development:

*A child's attention span is typically about 2-5 minutes per year of age.

That means a 4-year-old may focus for 8-20 minutes at a time. Short, engaging activities with movement breaks help children stay successful and confident.

*Reading just 20 minutes a day exposes children to approximately 1.8 million words per year!

Those minutes build vocabulary, imagination, listening skills, and a lifelong love of learning.

*When children build, pretend, create, and explore freely, they strengthen problem-solving skills, creativity, and emotional regulation.


* Sleep directly impacts behavior, focus, and mood the next day.
