Did you know preschoolers can ask around 200–300 questions a day? 🤖

Children ages 3–5 are naturally curious, and all those “why?” and “how?” questions are their way of figuring out how the world works. Every question they ask helps build important skills like language, thinking, and problem-solving.

Even when it feels like a lot, this stage is actually a big sign that your child’s brain is growing fast!

💡 Parent tip: You don’t always have to have the perfect answer. It’s just as helpful to say, “Let’s find out together!”—this teaches them that learning is exciting and never stops.

These little conversations every day make a big difference in their development ♥
