💖 Did You Know?

Washing hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds is one of the simplest and most effective ways to reduce the spread of germs. Soap helps lift dirt, bacteria, and viruses from the skin so they can be rinsed away with water.

Encourage your child to wash their hands:

- Before eating or helping prepare food.
- After using the restroom.
- After coughing, sneezing, or blowing their nose.
- After playing outside.
- When they arrive home or at school.



A fun way to make sure children wash long enough is to sing the "Happy Birthday" song twice while scrubbing their hands. This healthy habit helps protect not only your child but also their classmates, teachers, and family members.
